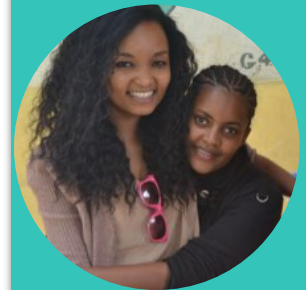

Each team had a different colored bandana where they had a team cheer, drama and sing off. They made no-sew bags out of T-shirts, enjoyed their skin care and nail care event. They improved their English in classes and games and lots of singing. All exams are in English yet they do not learn spoken English in school where the comprehension of English occurs. We have challenged the girls that in order to learn to speak English they must SPEAK ENGLISH.



We celebrate our 5th anniversary this year. Six years ago Ansley Bridges, Dee Bridges and I put our heads together and created a hope and a dream for Ethiopian young women. Today we celebrate the success of hundreds of girls in 7th -12th grades and 40 university students as well as 5 young women who graduated with their degrees in accounting, economics and Public Health Officer. I am living my dream "job" with an amazing team of leaders who love and guide our girls.
